NEW BUSINESS:

- **Player Registration for 2010 – Vicki**

Numbers – Girls - eight U9, eleven U10, seventeen U11, thirteen U12, thirteen U13, nine U14, seven U15, two U16, three U17 for a total of 83.

Boys – three U9, ten U10, nine U11, six U12, five U13, seven U14, ten U15, six U16, two U17 and one U18 for a total of 59.

Lauren indicated that for 2010 the U11's would be playing 9 vs. 9 in 2010.
- **AGM Review** – Rick went to the competitive soccer committee session, talked about trying to form a

club league throughout the state that would begin in March and run through mid July, probably only play a total of 5 different weeks. If you're scheduled to play in Yankton, there would be two games on the weekend, and then at the end of the year they would have a league champion. Cost would be about \$200 per team to play and if you attend all of the games there would be a \$100 refund. You would play each team twice, home and away. They voted to have them pursue it. They also talked quite a bit about the South Dakota cup. We really haven't heard too much about the SD cup here, if you win the tournament then you advance to the Regionals. Saturday talking about the software from active networks, for use in on-line registration of players. There is the possibility of sharing the software and Sheri will look into the costs, so much per player and so much for the set up. ODP for next year we may want to make the players and parents a little more aware of ODP as it's a good way to advance and let the college coaches see them. As a club we should make players aware and promote it and if they want to pursue it, it's \$60 to register and you can go to several and try out in multiple locations so the coaches can see them multiple sessions.

Lauren attended some referee sessions. Discussed how to arrange having a clinic scheduled in your town and how to contact the state referee committee, said they would send the link to the PowerPoint so Lauren could present it and a link to all of the contact people, very well put together PowerPoint. She also went to one on parent education, sales info and promoting Top Soccer, Kohl's cup, September is youth soccer month. Lauren thought it would be more on how to educate parents so they would be less problematic on the sidelines, but it seemed more like a sales presentation.

Sheri indicated that Becky was voted in as our District Commissioner.
